## **QUALITY ASSURANCE**

The School is committed to provide quality education to all the pupils in a serene and secular environment most conducive to the teaching-learning process. Pursuit of excellence is integral to the work culture in all Ideal Institutions and the school strives for the highest standard of excellence in all areas of its activities.

## **GENERAL RULES & REGULATIONS**

1. The school timing for Grade I to VII will be 9.30 am to 3.45 pm and for Grade VIII to X, it will be 8.00 am to 3.45 pm. The school office works from 8 am to 5 pm.
2. If a student is absent, the parent should submit request for leave in the space provided for this purpose.
3. a) Name of the student who is absent without information for 15 days continuously will be removed from the roll. School, under no circumstances, shall re-admit such students and therefore parents are requested to follow strictly the school's policy and rules.  
  
b) The School will not sanction leave of long periods for reasons like going abroad, Umra etc
4. Parents may meet the H.M./Principal/Vice Principal by prior appointment or at the following time. Monday - Saturday (2.00 pm -3.00 pm).
5. Parents / Guardians will not be permitted to meet the teachers during the school hours without the permission of the competent authority.
6. Students are strictly prohibited to come on motor vehicle to school/ campus.
7. Change of address should be informed in writing to the office.
8. Complaints should be notified through suggestion box or by meeting competent authority
9. Parents should come to school and sign the progress report when they are intimated.
10. Diary should be kept carefully and brought to the school every day.
11. Hairstyle should be according to the norms of school.

## **FOR THE ATTENTION OF PARENTS**

1. Students should take part in all the examinations.
2. Parents are expected to co-operate with the school authorities for the most effective learning facilitation.
3. Students should be guided to honour and obey the teachers who are always working for their proper growth and development.
4. Parents' whole-hearted participation is expected in all the school activities.
5. Students should be directed to follow the instructions noted in the diary.
6. Contact the teachers regularly in order to know and assess the progress of the children/wards
7. Parents should participate in the Parent Teacher meetings.
8. Permission should be obtained from the concerned HM/Principal to take the students home during the school hours.
9. Gold ornaments or other valuables should not be worn when students are sent to school.
10. Those who use the school vehicle should be ready at the right time at the boarding point.
11. Do not send children to school if they are suffering from infectious diseases like chicken pox, measles, mumps etc.
12. Do not send gifts to teachers without the permission of the Manager. As a policy this is not encouraged.
13. If you need to withdraw your child, please apply for T.C. at least four days in advance.
14. Pay the tuition fee and the transport fee regularly on or before the due date.
15. Children up to std IV are allowed to use only pencils for writing.
16. A medical certificate should be attached with the application for medical leave.
17. Meeting with Primary Teachers (I-IV) can be done on all Saturdays [10 am-3pm] and with Middle Class & Secondary Teachers, (V-X) on all Saturdays [2 pm - 3 pm].

## **Tips for parents to groom their children**

1. Wake up your child and send him/her to bed at a regular time.
2. Arrange a suitable place and time for your child to study
3. Let the family eat together at least one meal a day and listen to each other while having food.
4. Insist that your son/daughter reads the newspaper, listen to any one news broadcast and go through a weekly/magazine which you subscribe.
5. Let the computer be kept in a common place in the house.
6. Children can and should help with small household chores. This will create confidence and responsibility in the youngsters.
7. Involve him/her to clean his/her room, surroundings and clothes.
8. Allow your child to express her/his feelings. Let him/her know that he/she can turn to you. In-case he/she has over reacted, make him/her understand when the child has calmed down and became normal. Let him/her understand that you dislike or disapprove his/her wrong-doing but not himself or herself.
9. Appreciate and encourage your child as often as possible.
10. Evaluate your child's issues from his/her point of view.
11. School is your child's second home and teachers and school mates are his constant companions. Speak well of them.
12. Develop in him/her a positive attitude towards school, teachers and friends.

## **GUIDELINES TO THE STUDENTS**

1. Bring the diary daily to the class.
2. Be polite, friendly and well behaved always and every where.
3. Be obedient, respectful and courteous to your parents, elders and teachers.
4. After the first bell the students will be admitted to the class only with the permission of Principal/HM.
5. Wear the proper school uniform and be neat and tidy.
6. Learn to keep your house, your school and your surroundings clean.
7. Be attentive in the class and cultivate a love for learning.
8. Keep always to the left while going up or coming down the stair case.
9. Make-good for any kind of damage caused to the school property.
10. Take care of your belongings like the bag, books, money, clothes and other things brought to the school.
11. Speak English in school and in the school bus to improve your language fluency and always maintain a decency in conversation.
12. Tattooing is strictly prohibited.
13. Mobile phones, USB memory, iPad, electronic devices, etc should not be brought to school.
14. Pupils should not bring surplus money to schools.
15. Dyeing of hair or using hair gel is not permitted.
16. Students are strictly prohibited to run in the school corridors at all times.

## UNIFORM

1. Uniform is compulsory on all working days as well as special class days.
2. Students of Grade I to VII can wear colour dress on Thursdays, but others are not permitted to wear colour dress on working days.
3. Alternation in stitching uniforms will not be allowed. Low waist pants, skin fit pants & churi pants etc are not permitted as uniform.
4. All boys must keep their hair short. Exceptions on religious grounds will be made.
5. Girls with long hair should tie their hair into two plaits with a black hair band.
6. Girls (Muslim students) should wear black mafta with their uniform
